### Application and Decision Dates for admission to 2026/2027 school year

The following are the dates applicable for admission to Junior Infants

The school will commence accepting applications for admission on  
**5<sup>th</sup> January 2026.**

The school shall cease accepting applications for admission on  
**30<sup>th</sup> January 2026.**

The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is  
**13<sup>th</sup> February 2025.**

The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is within 2 weeks of date on letter of offer.

**Note: the school will consider and issue decisions on late applications in accordance with the school's admission policy.**

#### ***Explanation of each Priority Category:***

*(a) Priority Category 1: An Applicant Student who is a member of the Church of Ireland or a Protestant reformed church or is a member of a minority religion which has the same religious ethos, or a similar religious ethos to the programme of religious instruction/education which is provided in the school and who lives within the boundary of Monellan Parish.*

*(b) Priority Category 2: An Applicant Student who is a member of the Church of Ireland, or a Protestant reformed church or is a member of a minority religion which has the same religious ethos, or a similar religious ethos to the programme of religious instruction/education which is provided in the school and who lives within the boundary of Donaghmore Parish.*

*(c) Priority Category 3: An Applicant Student who lives within 5-mile radius of the School and who complies with the terms of this Policy*

*(d) Priority Category 4: All other Applicant Students who comply with the terms of this Policy*
